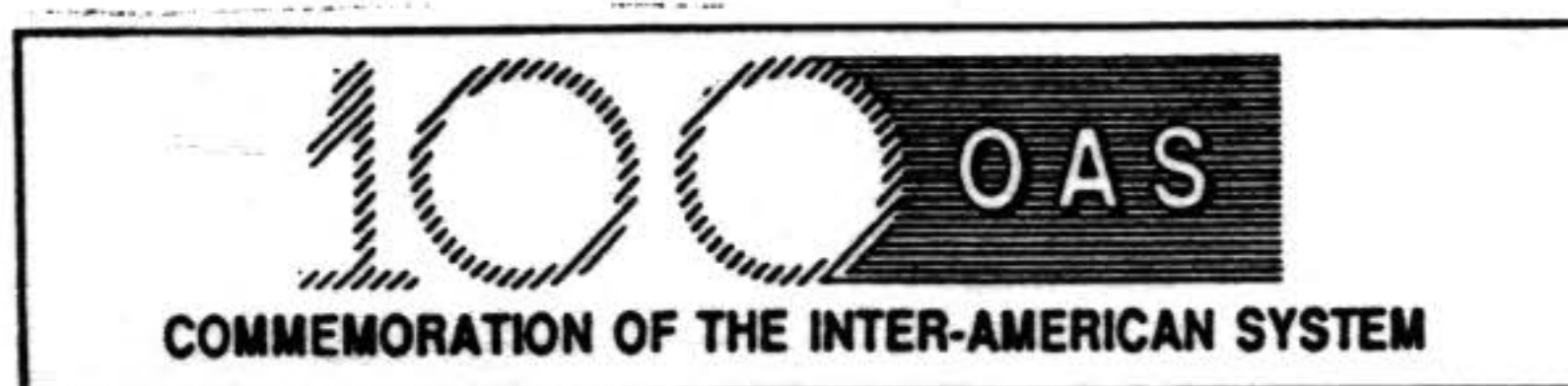

THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES

The Organization of American States (OAS) is the oldest regional organization in the world, dating back to the First International Conference of American States, held in Washington, D.C., which on April 14, 1890, established the International Union of American Republics. The Charter that governs the OAS was originally subscribed in Bogota in 1948.

The OAS has the following fundamental purposes to strengthen the peace and security of the Hemisphere; to seek the solution of political, juridical, and economic problems that may arise among the member states as well as promote, by cooperative action, their economic, social and cultural development.

The General Secretariat is the central and permanent organ of the OAS, with headquarters in Washington, D.C. The Secretary General is the legal representative and responds to the General Assembly, the supreme organ of the OAS. The Assistant Secretary General serves as advisory officer to the Secretary General and is the Secretary of the Permanent Council. Both the Secretary General and the Assistant Secretary General are elected by the General Assembly for a five-year term and may not be reelected more than once or succeeded by a person of the same nationality.

The staff of the General Secretariat is formed by international career personnel of the member states. Selection of the OAS staff is based on geographical distribution, professionalism, experience, efficiency and integrity criteria.

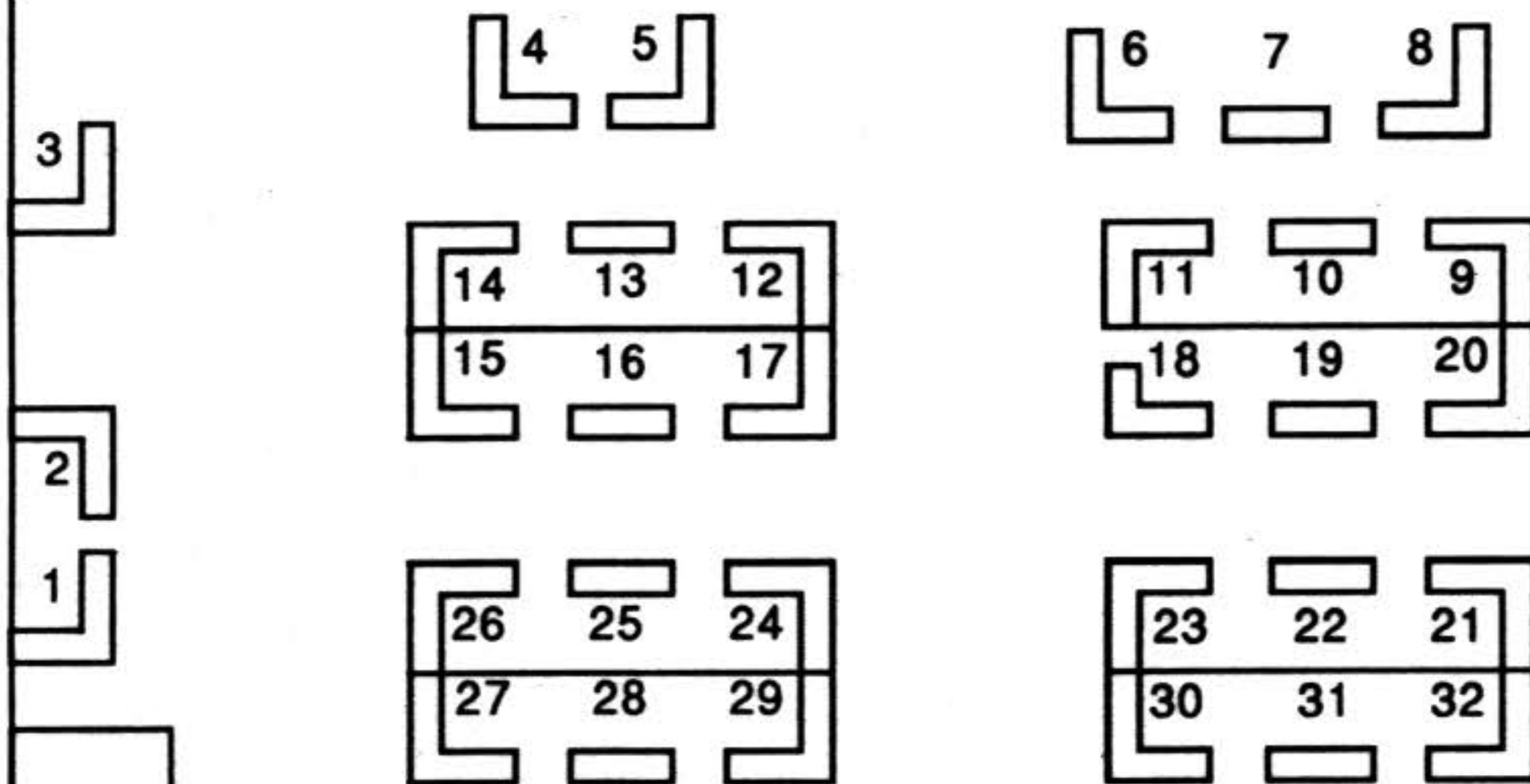
